FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE:

“When the time came for their purification according to the Law of Moses, they took him up to Jerusalem to offer him to the Lord, just as it is written in the Law of the Lord: Every first born male will be sacred to the Lord; and to offer the sacrifice of a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons, as prescribes the Law of the Lord.” (Cf.
