

“ Jesus found amongst the teachers in the Temple ”...

FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - LUKE -:

“His parents [...] not having found him, they returned in search for him at Jerusalem . After three days they found him in the temple, sitting amongst the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. And all those who heard him were filled with wonder for his intelligence and his answers”. (Lk 2,41.46)

MEDITATIONS ON THE MYSTERY:

Give us also the Grace to never again loose you [...]. Yes, Lord, having said this, give us also the Grace to have a true Spirit of Wisdom, a true Wisdom that comes from on High, and of a True Intelligence that comes not from this world... so that all (who listen) may be surprised at our every question or answer, but Lord, not for our glory but for Your Glory and for the Salvation of the Most number of Souls possible !”.
