In the 3rd Joyful Mystery, we read and we meditate undisturbed:



(C12 - Sr. S.M.S.)

"The Birth of Baby Jesus"...

FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - LUKE - :

"The angel of the Lord appeared to [the shepherds] and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were struck with great fear. The angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid; for behold, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Messiah and Lord. '" (Luke 2:9-11)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Christ was born in a poor stable, becoming little and poor Himself – and so showing us, even from His birth, the Spirit of Humility and Poverty! So tell me, you who are listening: in what spirit are you living out your mission? In what spirit are you imitating Jesus? (SLC, p. 130A)

FROM THE TEACHINGS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH:

- In regards to the importance of maintaining the poverty of the Gospel in the Church, Pope Francis says: "When disciples want to make a rich Church, a Church without freely given praise, the Church ages, she becomes a [nonprofit organization], she is lifeless." (FRANCIS, Meditation, 11 June 2013)
