In the 4th Joyful Mystery, we read and we meditate undisturbed:

"The Presentation of **Baby Jesus in the Temple**"...

FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - LUKE -:

"They took [the child] up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord.... When they had fulfilled all the prescriptions of the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth." (Luke 2:22, 39)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

How should we present ourselves to the Lord - with works or without works? The Lord says, "Behold, I am coming quickly, and I have my reward in hand, to render to every person according to his works" (cf. Rev 22:12). And the apostle, with a thundering and authoritative voice, confirms: "faith without works is dead" (cf. James 2:14, 17). (cf. SLC, pp. 183-184)
