

# "The Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River"...

# FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - MATTHEW -:

"After Jesus was baptized, he came up from the water and behold,... a voice came from the heavens, saying, 'This is my beloved son, with whom I am well pleased.'" (Matt 3:16-17)<sup>1</sup>

### **MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:**

Lord, give us the grace every day to be able to come out of this river of worldly (or even liturgical) patterns, a little as Your Son Jesus did. [In coming out of the river, Jesus] teaches us the true meaning of Baptism: not only having flowing water poured on one's head to be purified from sin, but, above all, having the Spirit of good will in our hearts which pushes us to search only (and at all costs) for your Will! (cf. SLC, p. 395)
