FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - MATHEW -:

"After Jesus was baptized, he came up from the water and behold,... a voice came from the heavens, saying, 'This is my beloved son, with whom I am well pleased.'" (Matt 3:16-17)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Lord, give us the grace to let our ego die in us every day, so that the Baptismal seed of the Spirit of God can resurrect within us: so that gradually, according to the seed of the triple munus (that is, the triple office of the Christian) given to us in Baptism, we may become Priests, Prophets, and Kings for the hearts of others – if, in Christ, we gradually cultivate this baptismal seed with the water of Biblical prayer and the sun of the Sacraments. - In regards to helping the Baptismal seed of the Spirit of God grow within us, St. Ephrem says: "With the grace of Baptism, we have your treasure [O Lord] hidden in our inmost being: a treasure which increases at the table of your Sacraments."
