FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - JOHN -:

"[The mother of Jesus] said to the servers, 'Do whatever he tells you.'...Jesus told them, 'Fill the jars with water.' So they filled them to the brim." $(John 2:5, 7)^{1}$

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Jesus, at Mary's request, changed the 6 jars of water into the 6 jars of wine - a figure of the Divine Spirit, so that we may espouse (well and with joy) the right ideal of life. (cf. SLC, p. 206G)

FROM THE TEACHINGS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH:

- In regards to transforming water into wine and not vice versa, St. Bonaventure warns: "You should not mix so much water of philosophy with the wine of Holy Scripture that the wine becomes water. This would be a terrible miracle; indeed, we read that Christ made water into wine and not the reverse." (BONAVENTURE, Hexaëmeron, XIX, 14)
