

# “Jesus Burdened with the Cross”...



## FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - MARK - :

*“They pressed into service a passer-by, Simon, a Cyrenian,...to carry his cross. They brought him to the place of Golgotha (which is translated Place of the Skull). They gave him wine drugged with myrrh, but he did not take it.” (Mark 15:21-23)<sup>1</sup>*

## MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Lord, give us the grace to discern the correct cross every day; and not to carry it by force (like the Cyrenian), but with love (like You), knowing that on our cross are many of our friends, relatives, acquaintances, etc... (cf. *SLC*, p. 336-337)
