FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - LUKE - :

"Then he led them [out] as far as Bethany, raised his hands, and blessed them. As he blessed them he parted from them and was taken up to heaven." (Luke 24:50-51)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Today, are we ascending towards eternal things? That is, are we moving towards the "heights" of immortal things? Or are we stuck to the earth like the overloaded side of a pair of scales? Are we like a hot air balloon [that can't rise], weighed down by too many possessions – or by too many sins?
