"The Glorious Resurrection of Jesus Christ"...

FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - MATTHEW - :

"Then the angel said to the women... 'I know that you are seeking Jesus the crucified. He is not here, for he has been raised just as he said... Then go quickly and tell his disciples, 'He has been raised from the dead, and he is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him." (Matt 28:5-7)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Lord, give us the grace to make our ego die within us every day so that the Baptismal seed of the Spirit of God may resurrect within us: which (as it is written) will bear many fruits of conversion, such as: "Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control" (Gal 5:22).¹ (cf.
