# ***“The Crowning of Mary, Queen of Heaven, of Earth, and the Angels and Saints”...***

## **FROM THE - BOOK OF REVELATION - :**

*“A great sign appeared in the sky: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.” ( Rev 12, 1 )...*

*“The one who sat on the throne said, ‘Behold, I make all things new’; then he said, ‘Write these words down, for they are certain and true. Behold they are accomplished ! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give water freely from the spring of life. The victor will inherit these gifts, and I will be his God, and he will be my son.’”... ( Rev 21, 5-7 )...*

## **MEDITATIONS ON THE MYSTERY:**

*“But we, today, Lord, have we accepted the crown of pungent insults, or have we gone up onto the Cross of Your full Will to desire one day the Victorious Eternal Crown of Glory of the children of God ? ... The Apostle say’s: ‘It is not possible to take God for a fool. Each person reaps what ever they have sown. Who sows in his flesh, from the flesh he reaps corruption; who sows in the Spirit, from the Spirit one reaps Eternal Life!’ ( Gal 6, 7 - 8 )... Yes, Lord, given that this life comes only once in all eternity, give us the Grace to abundantly sow in the Spirit, like so, other than abundantly reaping Eternal Life for us and for many others, we can reap also, rather than a minute eternal crown, The Great Eternal Crown forever, and from one Eternity to the next ! Amen !”... ( Friar Volantino V., in the SLC, 487-488 )...*

## **FROM THE TEACHINGS OF THE ( Catholic ) CHURCH :**

*- And even more, in regards to abundantly sowing in the Spirit so to abundantly reap Eternal Life ... like so says St. Cyrus of Jerusalem : “Convert in the favourable time, and on the day of salvation welcome the celestial treasure.. If you’ve worked a little you’ll receive a little, if instead you’ll have done a lot, a lot will be your pay !” (Office of Read, Sat. XIII Week, O.T. )*

*- Therefore, in regards to a major Glory for those who’re mostly committed to God... like so says St. Ambrose: “The more we’ve fought in this world so to obey to the precepts of the Lord, the more we’ll be blessed in the future life, and the more greater Glory we will earn” ( Office of readings. Fri. XIX Week of O.T. )*

- Mary, Queen of Peace ...

- Then, a possible “flash” song related to the mystery / or one says singing: “ Ave....., Ave....., Ave Maria ....”

*Then one goes on to the next Mystery that (as this one) for when possible must not take more than 5-7 minutes ...*
