Therefore if somebody wants to be great in Paradise, he ought to desire it, because, the greater the number of souls they'll save in Christ ( *cf. 1Cor 9,19-22* ), the greater the Glory that the Almighty God will grant them in Heaven, no more or no less, but only upon the basis of the effort in their work towards helping their neighbor, like so to let them arrive to the street that guides not to ruin, but to eternal Joy !..
