FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - LUKE -:

"During those days Mary set out and traveled to the hill country in haste to a town of Judah, where she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth [was] filled with the Holy Spirit" (Luke 1:39-41)1
