# **"The Visitation of Mary** to Saint Elizabeth"...



## FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - LUKE - :

"When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the holy Spirit, cried out in a loud voice and said, 'Most blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb. And how does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?" (Luke 1:41-43)<sup>1</sup>

#### **MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:**

Who will climb, like Mary, the mountain of the Lord? "He who has innocent hands and a pure heart, he who does not tell lies or swear deceitfully to his neighbor: this is the one who will obtain blessing from the Lord" (cf. Ps 24:3-5). Therefore, Lord, give us such powerful and eternal blessings as Mary obtained when she went to visit her cousin St. Elizabeth who was in need. (cf. SLC, p. 87)
