"The Visitation of Mary to Saint Elizabeth"...

FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - LUKE - :

"Mary said, 'My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my savior: for he has looked upon his handmaid's humility." (Luke 1:46-48)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

In regards to humility, Lord, we ask You for the great grace to be able (in some way) to imitate Mary: who, although she knew that she was the Mother of God, did not wait for her neighbor to come to her. Instead, it was she who first set off towards her neighbor! (cf. *SLC*, p. 88)

FROM THE TEACHINGS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH:

- In regards to humility, St. Anthony of Padua says: "Those who lack humility find themselves in the greatest misery. ... It is with humility that one reaches glory."
