"When the days were completed for their purification according to the law of Moses, they took him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, just as it is written in the law of the Lord..." (Luke 2:22-23)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

In addition to Confession, the first offering or sacrifice that You ask of us, Lord, is that, with our every action, we sacrifice our old man: stripping it of its worldly habits and its obstinate horns of pride (cf. 1Kings 18:31-39) and washing and purifying it over and over with the pure water of the four "jars" of the Gospels (cf. John 4:13). (cf. SLC, p. 154)
