FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - MATHEW -:

FROM THE TEACHINGS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH:

- In regards to baptism and circumcision, Pope Innocent III says, "Baptism has taken the place of circumcision... Therefore, just as the he who was circumcised was not lost to his people (cf. Gen 17:14), so he who is born again of water and the Holy Spirit will obtain entry into the kingdom of heaven."
