FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - JOHN -:

"His mother said to the servers, 'Do whatever he tells you.' Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus told them, 'Fill the jars with water.' So they filled them to the brim." (John 2:5-7)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Jesus, at Mary's request, changed the six jars of water into six jars of wine, a figure of the Divine Spirit – that we might be able to espouse well, and with joy, the right ideal of life. (cf. SLC, p. 206G)
