## FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - MATTHEW -:

"Jesus took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and giving it to his disciples said, 'Take and eat; this is my body.'" (Matt 26:26)<sup>1</sup>

#### MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Lord, give us the ability to incarnate Your Divine Verb to the point of becoming a little or great living Eucharist, just as it is written in the Liturgy: "Let our life be Eucharist for the others, loving our neighbors as ourselves." (cf. SLC, p. 123)
