FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - LUKE -:

"[Jesus] took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body, which is given for you; do this in memory of me.' And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you. " (Luke 22:19-20)^l
