## FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - MATTHEW -:

"While they were eating, Jesus took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and giving it to his disciples said, 'Take and eat; this is my body.'" (Matt 26:26)<sup>1</sup>

### MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:
