FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - JOHN -:

"[Jesus said to them:] I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." (John 6:51)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

We must recognize the Body of the Lord in the Holy living Eucharist, because it is written, "anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body, eats and drinks judgment on himself" (1Cor 11:29). (cf. *SP*, p. 95)

We must eat and drink worthily, however, because whoever receives Him unworthy eats and drinks his own condemnation by failing to discern the body of the Lord or distinguish between it and other foods."
