"Jesus Scourged at the Column"...

FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO – MARK- :

"Pilate, wishing to satisfy the crowd, released Barabbas to them and, after he had Jesus scourged, handed him over to be crucified." (Mark 15:15)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

If we hold on tightly to You, Lord, as You held on tightly to the Column of the Father – even to the point of having our hands bound to the Truth, patiently enduring the whipping that totally disfigures our dignity: then in some way we, too, will be true Columns of the Church. (cf. SLC, p. 283)

FROM THE TEACHINGS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH:

- In regards to being able to become true spiritual columns of the Church, St. Anthony of Padua says: "These columns stand for the Apostles, who are rightly called ... columns, because they received firmness in the Resurrection of Christ, and unfailing strength in the sending of the Holy Spirit."
