FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO – **MATTHEW** - :

“While [Pilate] was still seated on the bench, his wife sent him a message, ‘Have nothing to do with that righteous man. I suffered much in a dream today because of him.’ The chief priests and the elders persuaded the crowds to ask for Barabbas but to destroy Jesus.” (Matt. 27:19-20)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Lord, give us the grace to imitate (in some way) the wife of Pontius Pilate, who recognized the Righteous Man – so clearly that she also had the courage to call to account one of the powerful rulers of the earth. (cf. *SLC*, p. 284)

FROM THE TEACHINGS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH:

- In regards to correction, the Second Council of Constantinople affirms: *“Not only is the wicked man condemned, but also the one who could have corrected the others and failed to do so.”*
