FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - MARK -:

"[W]eaving a crown of thorns, [they] placed it on him. They began to salute him with, 'Hail, King of the Jews!' and kept striking his head with a reed and spitting upon him. They knelt before him in homage. And when they had mocked him, they...led him out to crucify him." (Mark 15:17-20)1

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Lord, when we speak, give us the grace to have the right sharpness of tongue: not to do harm, but to operate – that is, to cut away [what is useless or harmful] and graft in [what the soul needs]. But before we perform this operation, we pray for the grace to give the "anesthesia" first: with the sweet grace of love, respect, and charity! (cf. SLC, p. 311)
