## FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - MARK -:

"Those passing by reviled him,...and said, 'He saved others; he cannot save himself. Let the Messiah, the King of Israel, come down now from the cross that we may see and believe.' Those who were crucified with him also kept abusing him." (Mark 15:29, 31-32)<sup>1</sup>
